

Postdoctoral Fellow in Causal Inference

Professor [Thomas D. Cook](#) is seeking a postdoctoral fellow to work with him for at least two years, preferably three. The general topic is methodological research in causal inference, and the person hired should have a developed or growing interest in quasi-experimental designs and the analyses that go with them. Thus, the person should have a strong background in quantitative skills and experience using statistical software (STATA, R, SAS, etc.). PhDs in any social science or statistics will be considered. The successful applicant can expect to work in a very collegial team setting with opportunities to publish both individual and team papers and to be actively mentored for later life as a faculty member.
